- ROBOTIC WELDING OPERATOR -

Location: DCI Metal Stamping Division, Reservoir

Function: The MIG Robotic Welder Operator (Trunion) shall ensure

parts are manufactured or processed in accordance with process control plans and that production output targets

are met.

Authority: The MIG Robotic Welder Operator (Trunion) has the

authority to:

 Stop their process and notify the Area Supervisor of any quality concerns.

 Sign off as complete their operation on the work Order Card.

- Adjust and set Robots to Production specifications.
- Operate machines and process work as instructed by the Area supervisor.
- Identify and segregate non-conforming stock.

Job Duties & Responsibilities:

- (a) Ensuring parts are made or processed in accordance with instructions listed on the Process Control Plan and Inspection Sheet
- (b) Efficiently and effectively operating single robot MIG weld cells
- (c) Efficiently and effectively operating double trunion robot MIG weld cells
- (d) Adjusting and setting Robotic Weld machines to specification.
- (e) Ensuring parts are made or processed in a prompt manner and production output figures are met.

- (f) Identifying work in progress with Work Order Cards and signing off their operation as complete.
- (g) When required, identifying similar parts with "Keep Separate" Cards.
- (h) Working in a safe manner and in accordance with safety policies and procedures and reporting potential or actual hazards to their elected health and safety representative. Setting a positive example to others in the work area.
- (i) Observing all workplace rules and regulations.
- (j) Assisting the Quality Assurance Department with any customer concerns/problems resolution.
- (k) Ensuring their work areas are kept clean, neat and tidy at all times.
- (I) Training new personnel on operating Robots. Eg: gauging, loading and unloading of parts, highlighting the Quality requirements, maintenance requirements to the Robot.
- (m) Allocating stock in and out of Robot weld area.
- (n) Being aware of DCI's Environmental Management System and programs, Environmental Policy and where the Policy is located in the plant, and the consequences of deviating from specified operating procedures.
- (o) Carrying out tasks that may cause significant environmental impacts, as required.
- (p) Carrying out other production tasks as nominated by the Area Supervisor or Manufacturing Manager
